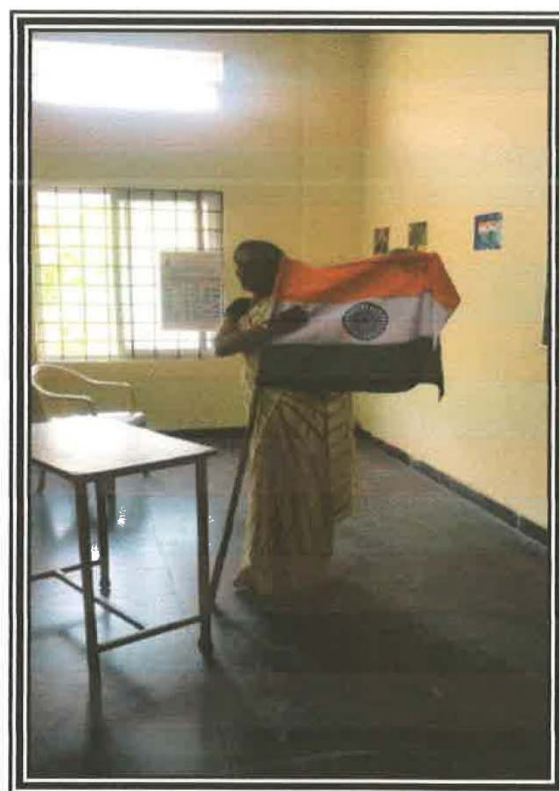
ACADEMIC YEAR 2017-18


National Voters Day

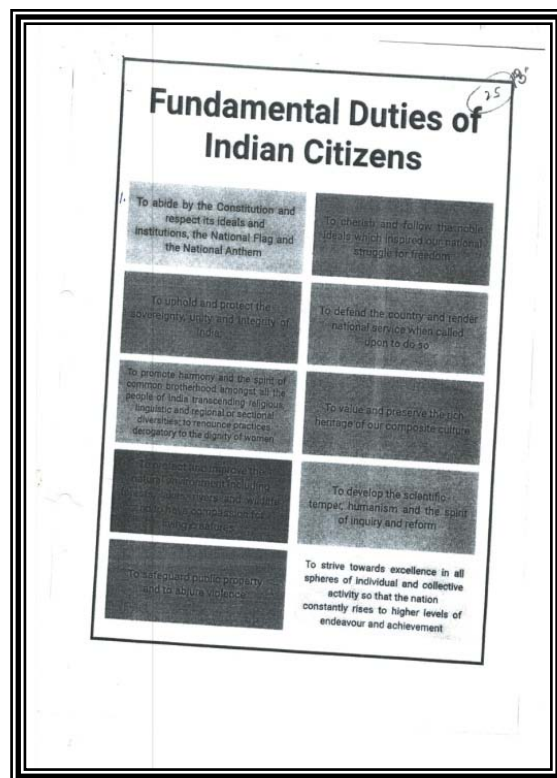
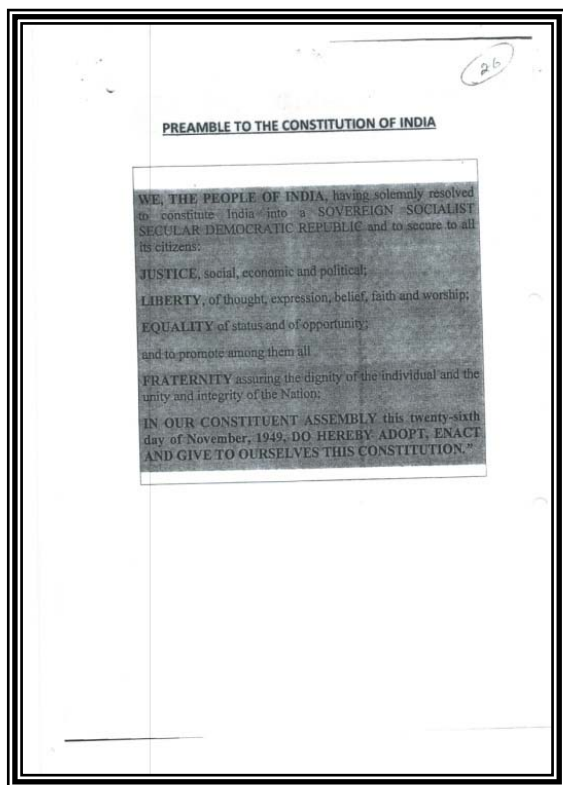
Constitution Day

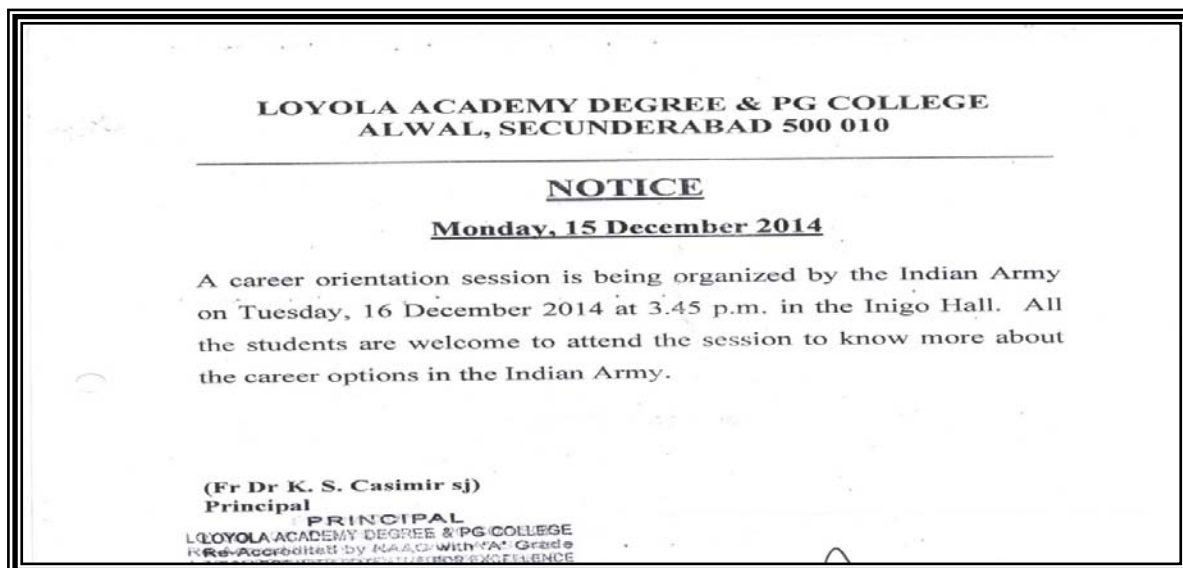
ACADEMIC YEAR 2014-15

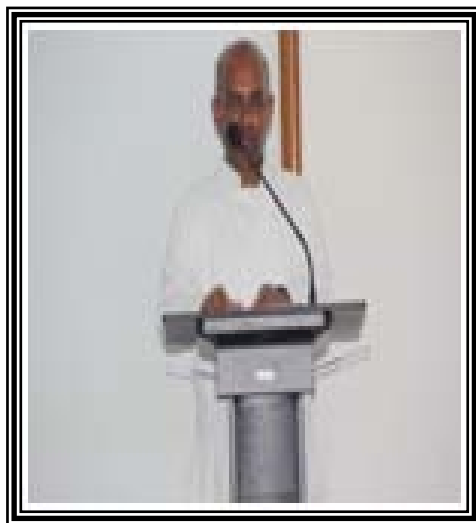
INAUGURATION OF NSS UNIT
