

Analysis of Students Satisfaction Survey on Teaching Learning Process

1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?





2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?




Analysis: The above analysis represents that 50.8 % teacher prepare thoroughly in the class and 46 % students feel satisfied about teacher preparation in the class.

3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?




Analysis: 64.5% students feel that teacher always effective in communication. 26.6 % students feel that teacher some effective in communication while delivering the lecture in the class.

4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as




Analysis: 37.9% students feel very good in context to teaching approach and 43.5% feel Excellent followed by 13.7% who feels good for the teachers.

5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.





6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?





7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.





8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.





9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.





10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.





11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.





12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.





13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.





14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.





15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.





16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.





17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.





18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.




