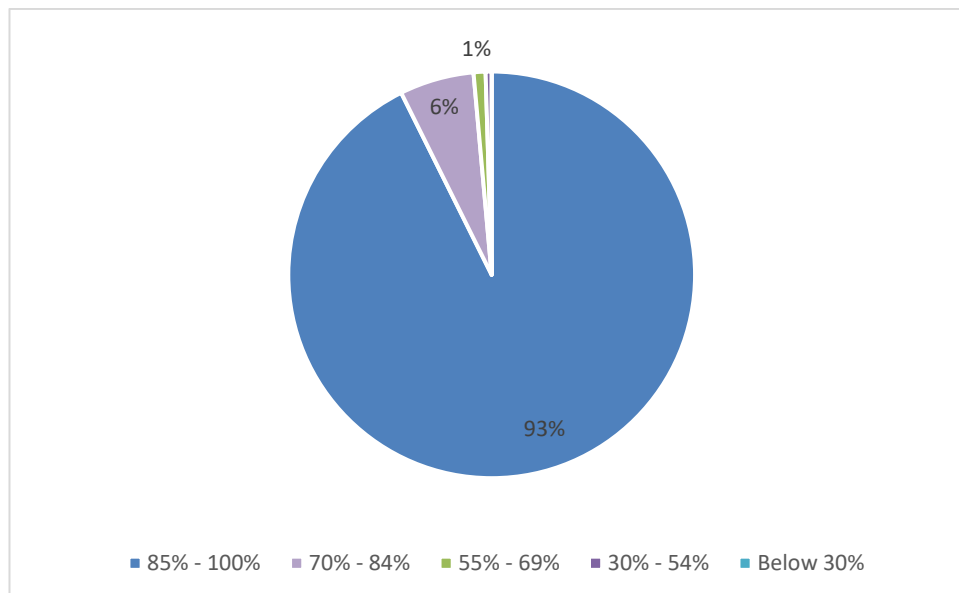


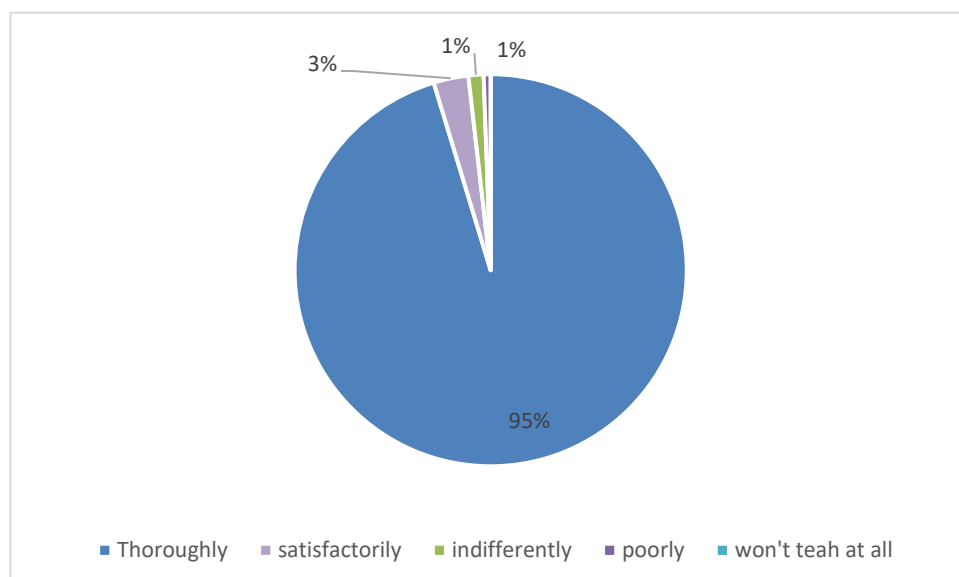
Analysis of Students Satisfaction Survey on TLP 2019-20

1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?



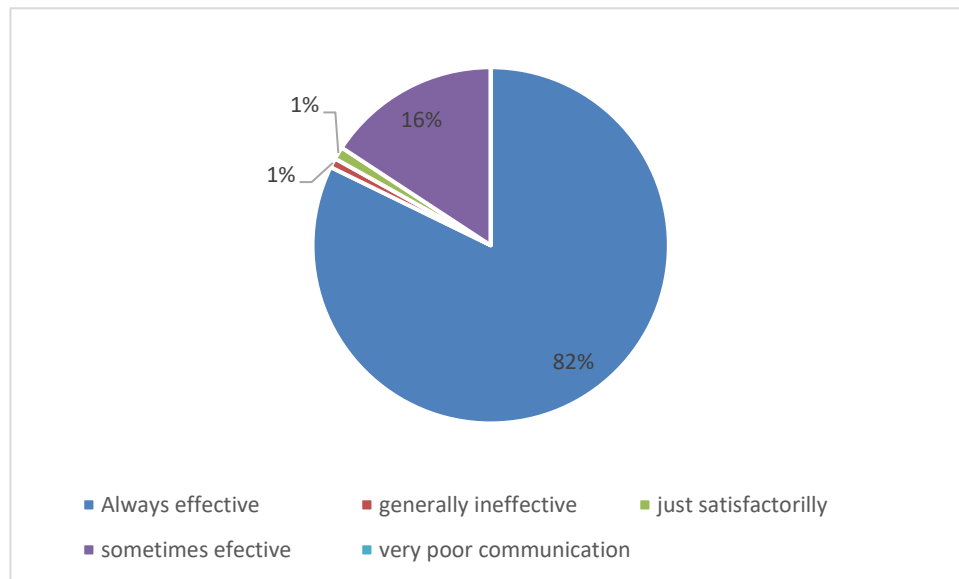

2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?



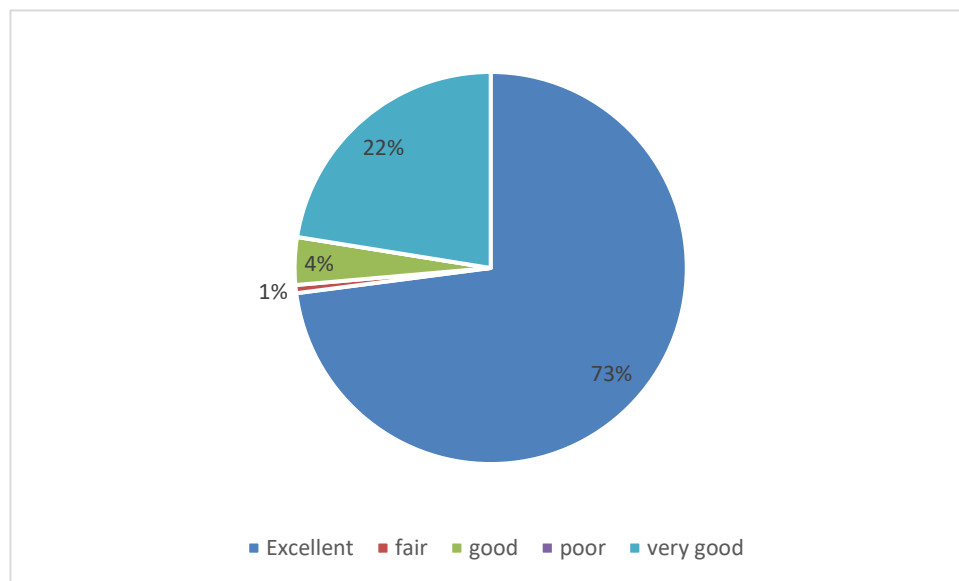
Analysis: The above analysis represents that 95% teacher prepare thoroughly for the class.

3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?



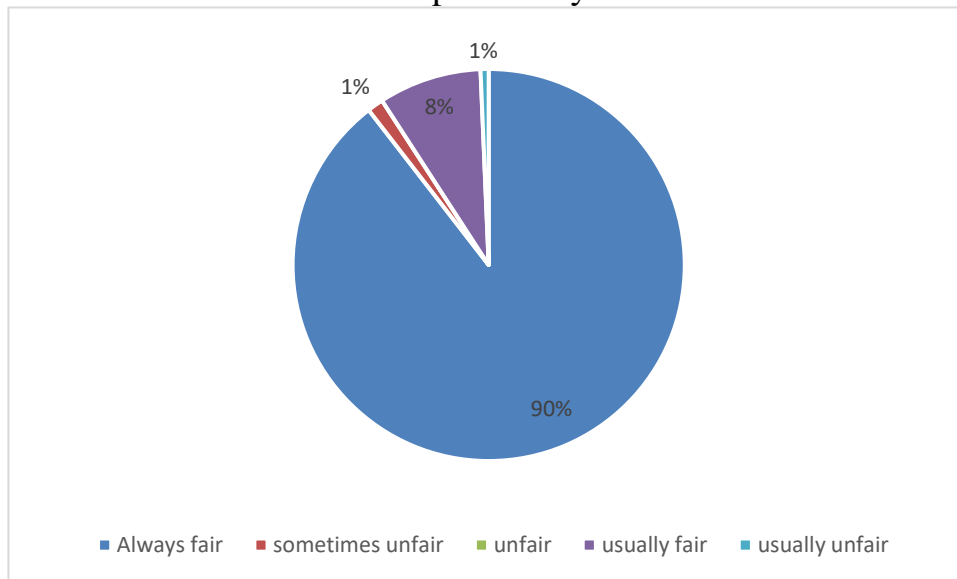
Analysis: 82% students feel that teacher are always effective in communication.

4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as



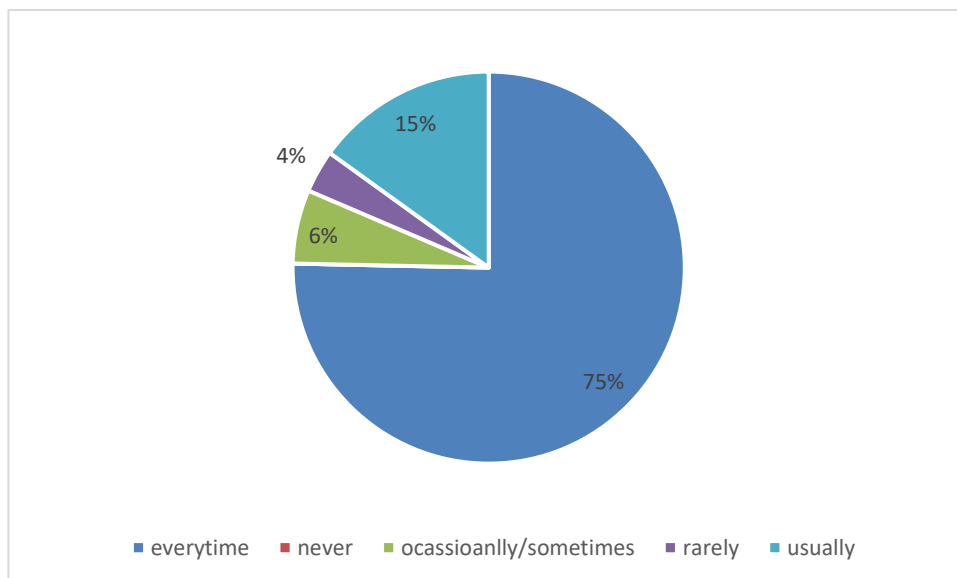
Analysis: 73% students feel that teaching approach of teachers is excellent.

5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.



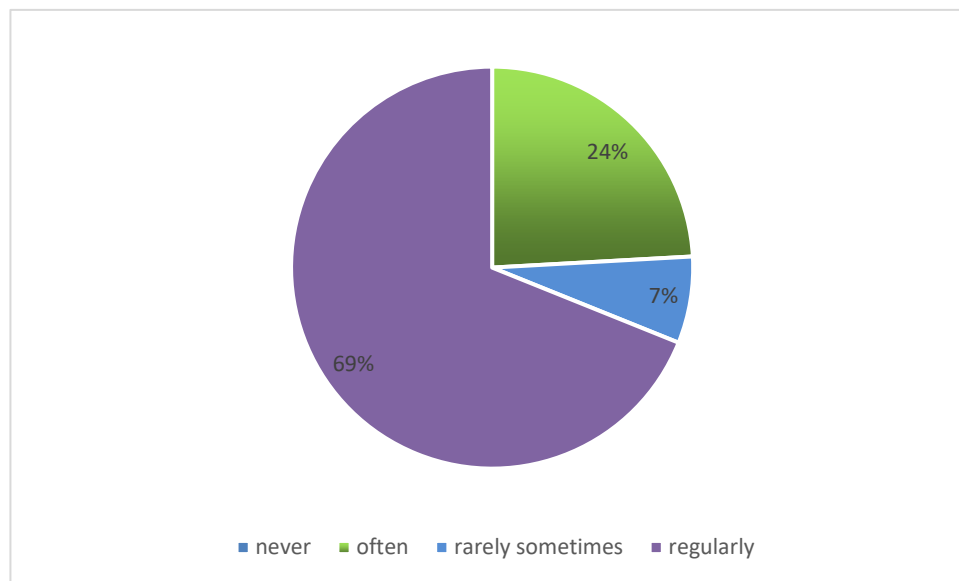
1. Analysis: 90% students feel that internal evaluation process by the teachers is always fair.

2. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?



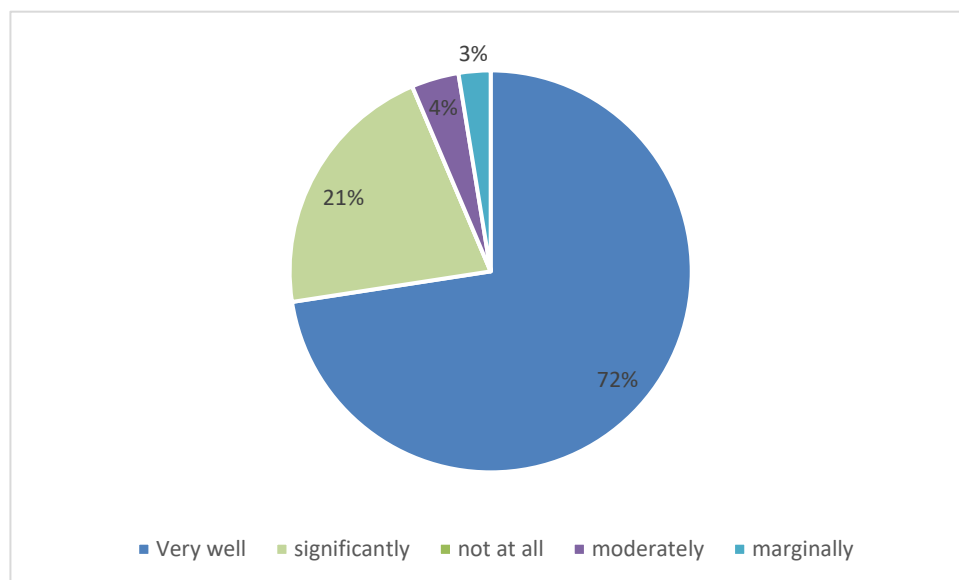
Analysis: 75% students feel that teachers discuss the performance of the students with students every time.

3. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.



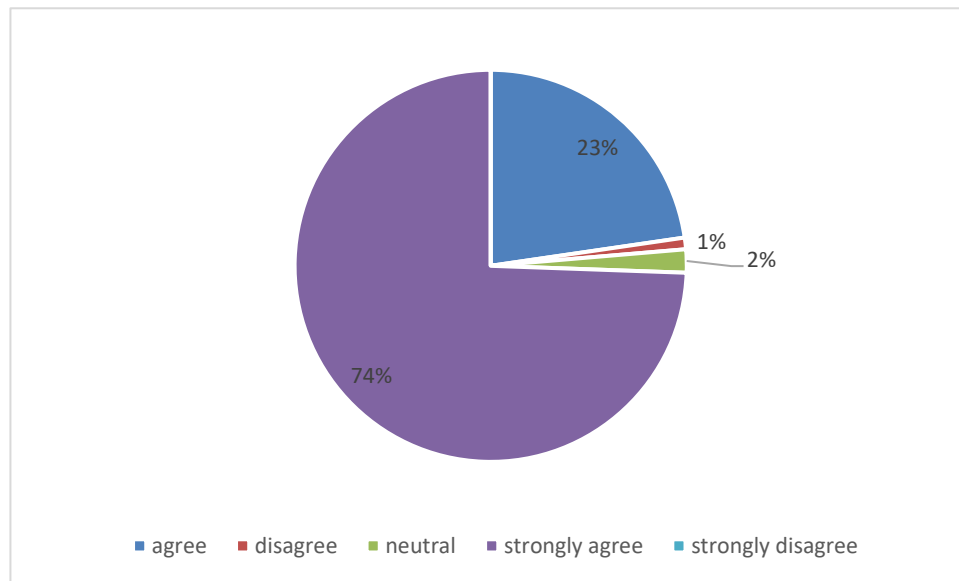
Analysis: 69 % students feel that institute regularly takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.

4. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.



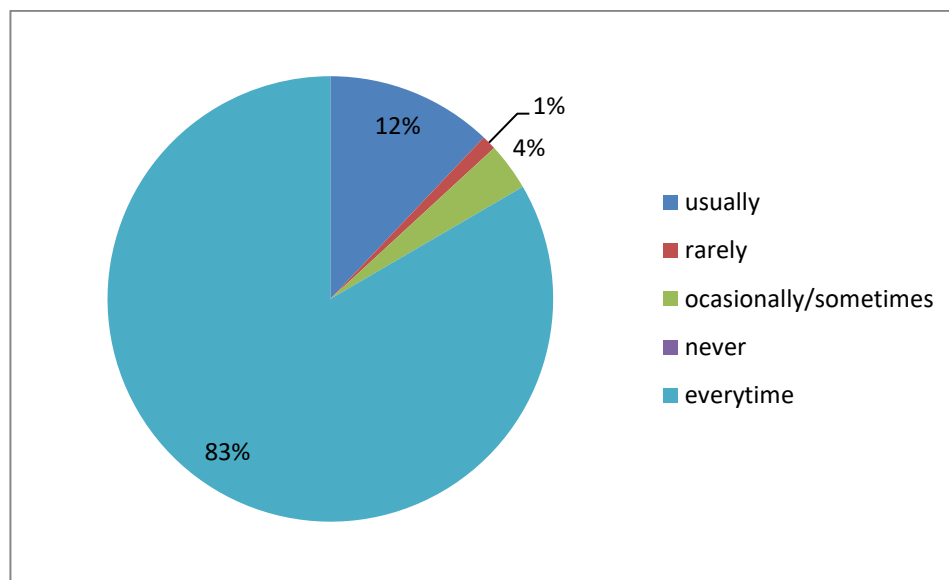
Analysis: 73 % students feel that mentoring process of institute is very effective in facilitating cognitive, social and emotional growth.

5. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.



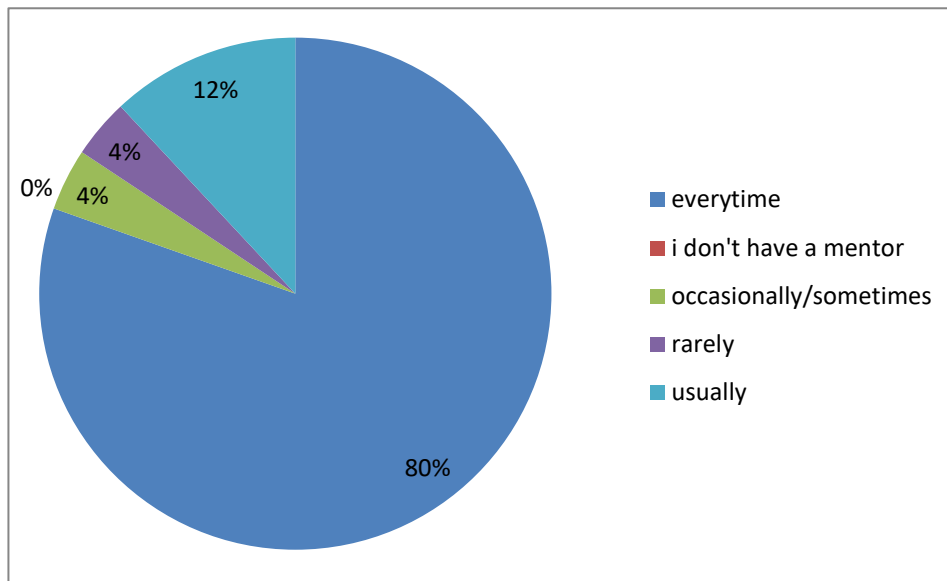
Analysis: 74 % students strongly agree that the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

6. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.



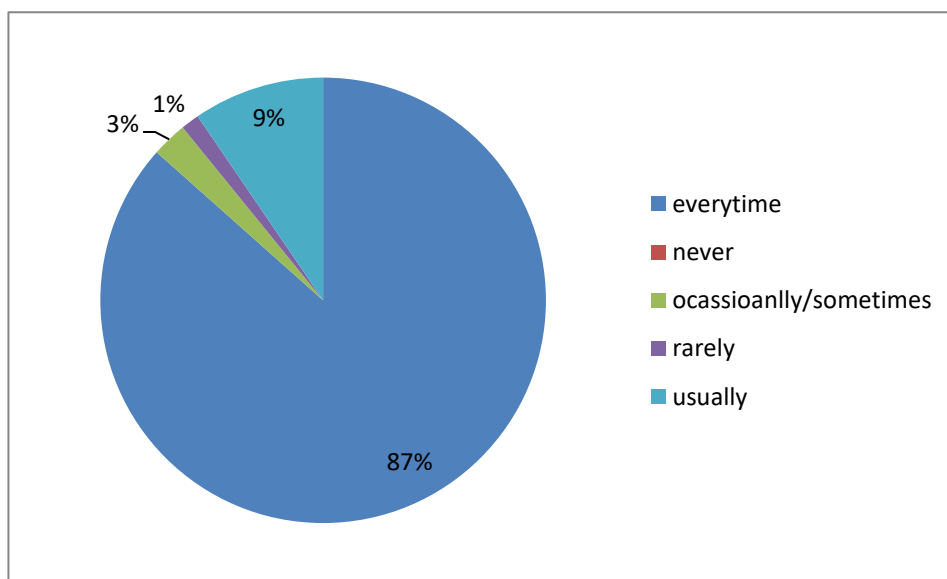
Analysis: 83 % students feel that teacher every time inform about expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

7. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.



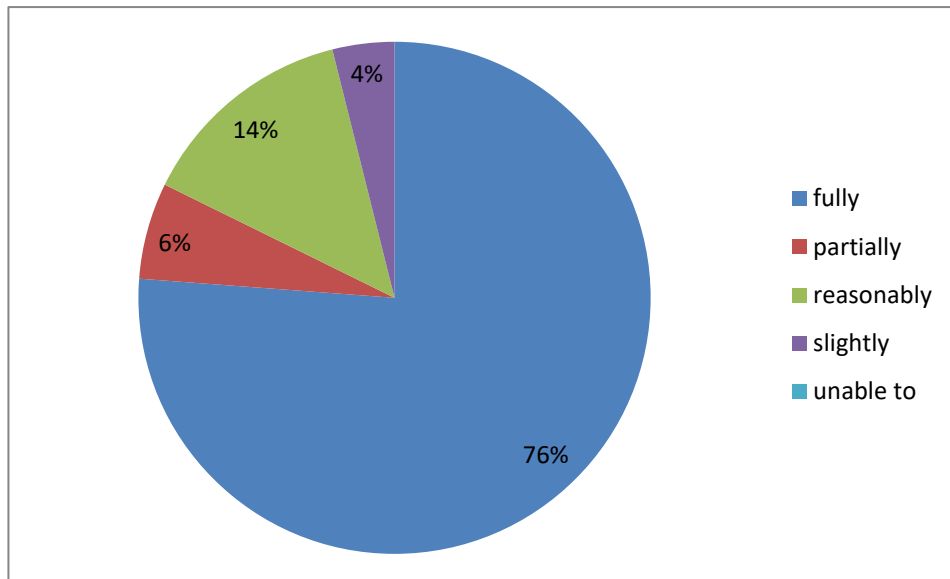
Analysis: 80 % students feel that mentors take necessary follow-up for assigned task every time.

8. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.



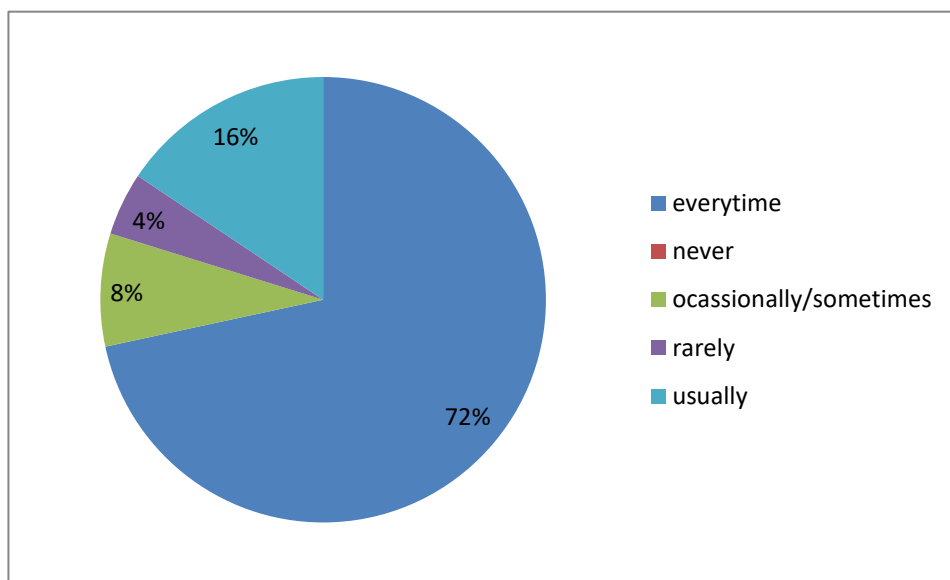
Analysis: 87 % students feel that teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications in the classroom every time.

9. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.



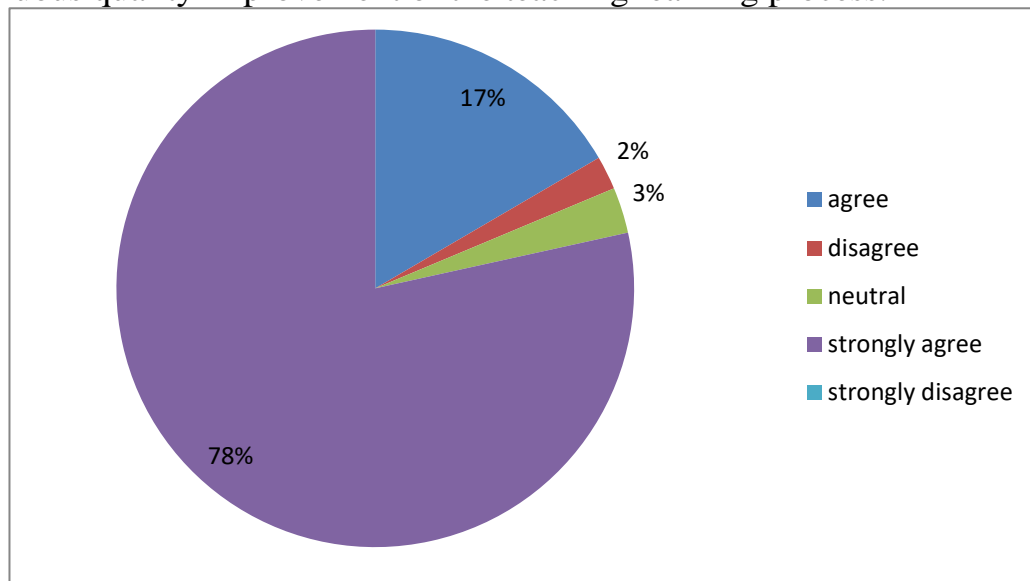
Analysis: 76 % students feel that teachers fully/ reasonably identify the strengths of students and try to encourage the students with providing right level of challenges.

10. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.



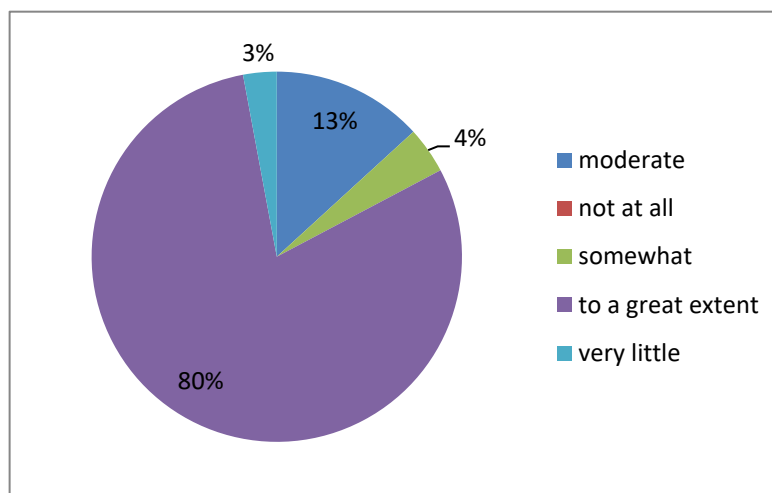
Analysis: 72% students feel that teachers are able to identify the weaknesses of the students and help them to overcome from this weakness every time.

11. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring,review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.



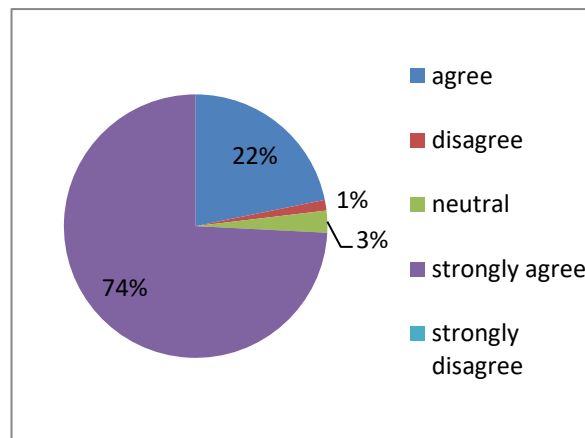
Analysis: 7 8 % students strongly agree that institution makes efforts to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

12. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.



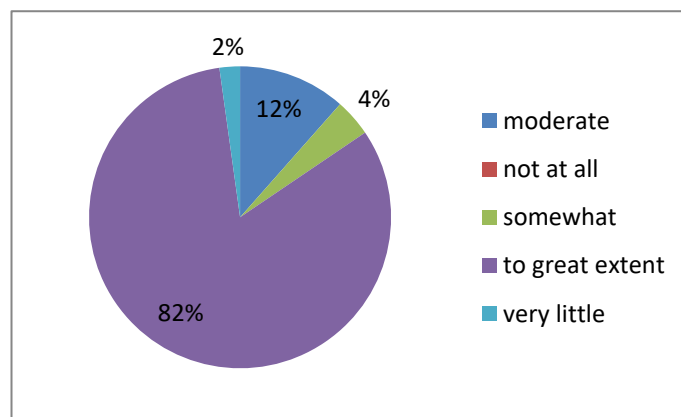

13. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.



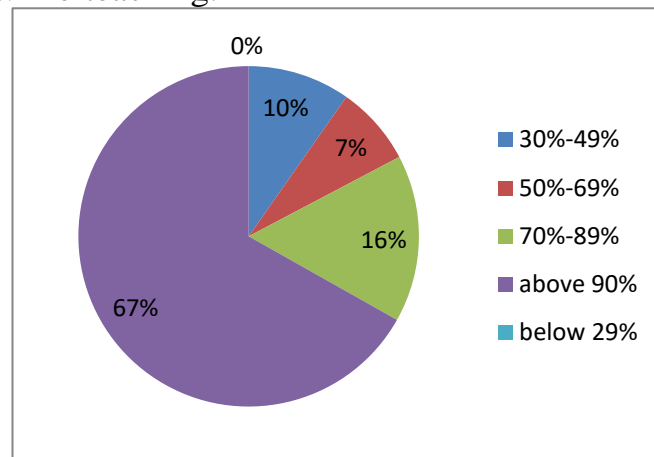
Analysis: 74% students strongly agree that the teachers encourage us to participate in extracurricular activities.

14. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.



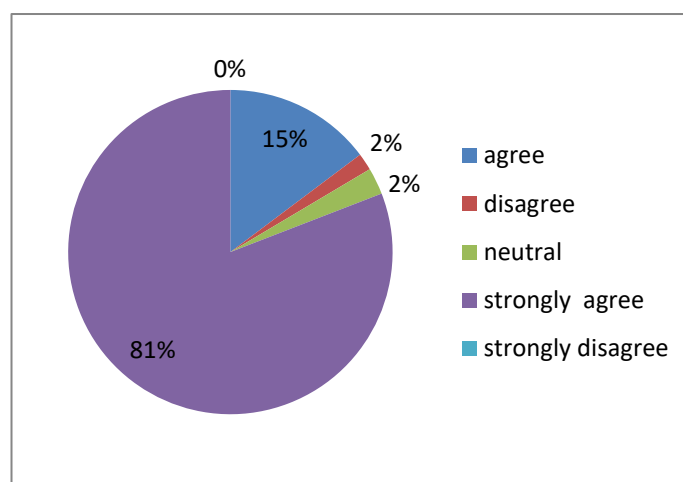
