



1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?





2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?




Analysis: The above analysis represents that 74.53% teacher prepare thoroughly for the class.

3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?




Analysis: 88.34% students feel that teacher are always effective in communication

4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as




Analysis: 70.51% students feel that teaching approach of teachers is excellent

5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.




Analysis: 76.54% students feel that internal evaluation process by the teachers is always fair

6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?




Analysis: 76.68% students feel that their performance in assignments were discussed with them.

7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.




Analysis: 84.32% students feel that the institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities.

8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.




Analysis: 78.15% students feel that the institution facilitates them in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.




Analysis: 78.42% of students feel that the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.




Analysis: 73.32% students feel that teachers inform them about their expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.




Analysis: 73.59% students feel that mentor usually take necessary follow-up for assigned task.

12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.




Analysis: 84.18% students feel that teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications every time.

13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.




Analysis: 79.89% students feel that teachers fully identify the strengths of students and try to encourage them by providing right level of challenges.

14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.




Analysis: 80.03 % students feel that teachers are able to identify their weaknesses of the students and help them to overcome from this weakness.

15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.




Analysis: 87.27% students strongly agree that institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

16. The institute / teachers use student- centric methods, such as experiential learning, and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.




Analysis: 76.81 % students feel that the institute / teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.

17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.




Analysis: 84.58% students strongly agree that the teachers encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities.

18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employ ability skills to make you ready for the world of work.




