1. Name of the Department: M.Sc. Bio – technology

Name of the seminar: A two day webinar on "Theragnostic, therapeutics, and vaccine research on covid-19, prospects and challenges"


Date: 8th -9th June 2020

REPORT

Title: The department of biotechnology (PG), Loyola academy degree and PG college, Secunderabad, conducted a two day webinar on 8th and 9th June, 2020 entitled as "Theragnostic, therapeutics and vaccine research on covid-19, prospects and challenges". This webinar was conducted to enlighten the students about the pandemic and the current state of art methodologies that are used to diagnose the virus and the treatments used. The webinar was conducted in 4 sessions 2 sessions each day each session conducted by resource scientists from different prestigious institutions.

On day one that is 8th june, the first session was conducted by Dr. Irabhatnagar, senior scientist biomedicine and biotechnology research area, Centre for Cellular and Molecular biology on the topic theronostics of covid-19. The session started off by the explanation of the origin of Corona virus its basic structure and its statistics, different routes the disease spreads and its symptoms. Dr. Irabhatnagar mam also spoke about the different diagnostic techniques used such as Nucleic Acid Amplification Test (NAAT), serological testing, viral sequencing, viral culture their advantages and disadvantages and also immunoassay like antibody test and antigen tests. Mam also spoke about first covid-19 testing kit made in India

by my lab life solutions and other innovative methods used in testing covid-19 and also the different strategies in vaccines and therapies.



The second session was conducted by Dr. Chattopadhay, director of National Institute of Traditional Medicine, belgavi on the topic covid-19 fight between modern science and primitive creature. Dr. Chattopadhay sir started the session with basics ,explanation of virus its definition, characters, the evolutionary changes that took place in virus and what were the consequences of these changes and its relative impact on humans. Then sir spoke about the covid family history, the Corona virus its structure, transmission characters and the route of entry into humans, symptoms, stages of infection. Then sir elucidated the research and development in about shell as test, treat and prevent. He explained that the viral infection can be controlled by public health measures vaccination and drug development and also the treatment methods by antiviral drugs and other potential drugs.




On day two that is on 9th July the session was conducted by Dr. Ashwin dalal, head, diagnostic division at Centre for DNA fingerprinting and diagnostics(CDFD) on the topic Molecular sequencing of SARS covid -19. Dr. Ashwin dalal sir started the session by

classifying the human disorders into totally genetic and totally environmental and the the diseases which fall into the above two categories and also the diseases which fall in between both the categories. Sir spoke about the different types of genetic testing methods like cytogenetic testing, molecular testing and biochemical testing. He explained the DNA based testing methods which are complimentary hybridization and PCR based testing which are important techniques in the Molecular screening of the SARS covid-19 virus. He spoke about mutations and the different types of mutations and also the methods to detect different types of mutations like the Sanger's method is used to detect point mutations and for the detection of deletion and duplication type of mutations array comparative and genomic hybridization methods are used. He explained the viral sequencing methods in detail like the Sanger's sequencing method, microarrays based method and the next generation sequencing method. He explained the next generation sequencing method in detail like its cost its effectiveness and the different types their advantages and disadvantages. He also spoke about the importance of bioinformatics in Molecular analysis. He spoke about the utility of Molecular diagnostics. He explained how the testing is done for covid-19 in CDFD. He spoke in detail about the whole genome sequencing and data analysis of SARS covid-19.



The webinar was concluded by the lecture of the last speaker Dr. Nouruddin Khan, department of animal sciences, school of life sciences, University of Hyderabad, on the topic immuno based therapy for the containment of covid-19. Dr. Nouruddin Khan sir started the session by speaking about the statistics of the spread of covid-19 its symptoms and the classification of virus. Sir briefed about the host immune response towards the virus and its potential therapeutic approaches by the use of antivirals, immunotherapies and vaccines. He spoke about the different virus vaccines the array of vaccines and also the problems associated with the use of traditional vaccines. He talked about the nano formation strategies, mZno nano capsules and the use of antibody based therapies for the treatment of the viral infection.


- **Purpose**: The objective of the webinar was to generate awareness about the trend of Data Science and Artificial Intelligence in today's world.

He also mentioned about several government initiatives like ICDS, Feed India campaign to overcome food shortage. Community kitchens have been established to help the people who are below poverty line. Food inspectors have been initiated to inspect the perishable foods like meat, milk, fruits and vegetables.

- 4)Difference between an entrepreneur and a businessman








The students were also enlightened with the top 10 skills the 21 century learners must possess which includes analytical thinking, leadership, social influence, critical thinking and many more.




DAY3:



 - e. Decision Factors







DAY5:






DAY6:


Name of the seminar: From Pre production to post production- Role of visual effects

OBJECTIVE: To encourage students to utilise their savings by investing and yielding returns. This webinar gives a head start to them by educating them about it.




OBJECTIVE

<u>DAY-1</u>- Session -1 was addressed by Dr.P. Lalitha garu, Head, Department of Mathematics, St. Francis college for women.







The workshop was a successful event.



Outcome: The webinar gave insight knowledge on the foods to be taken and foods to avoid during the pandemic conditions.







Participant's Profile:


