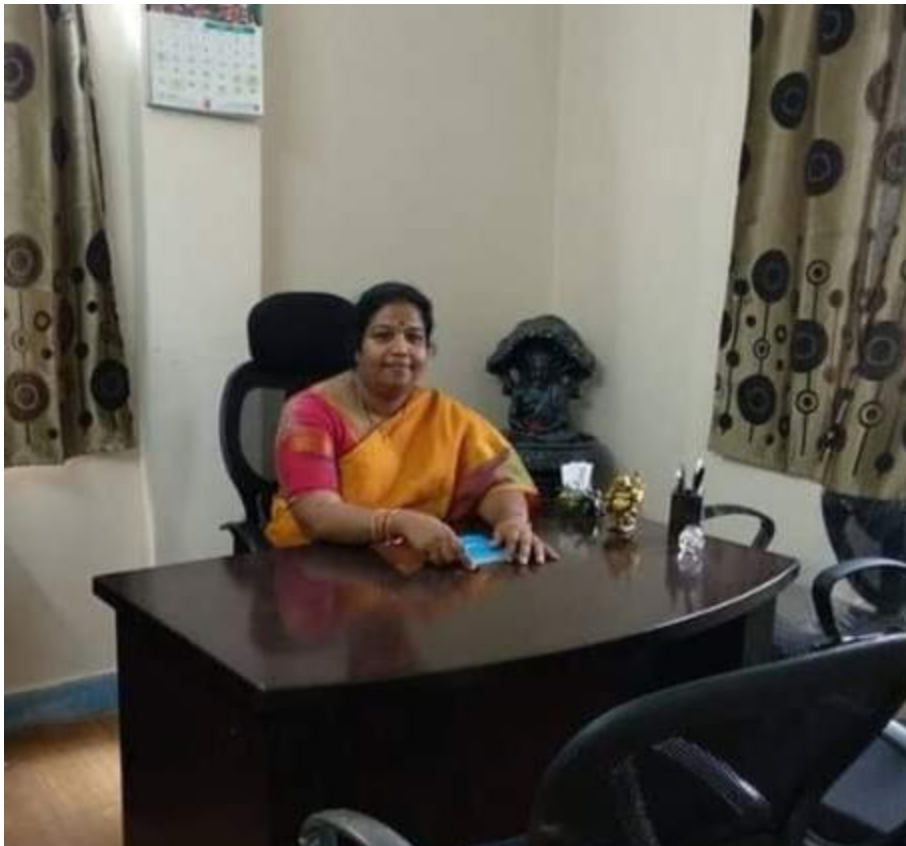
CONCLUSION

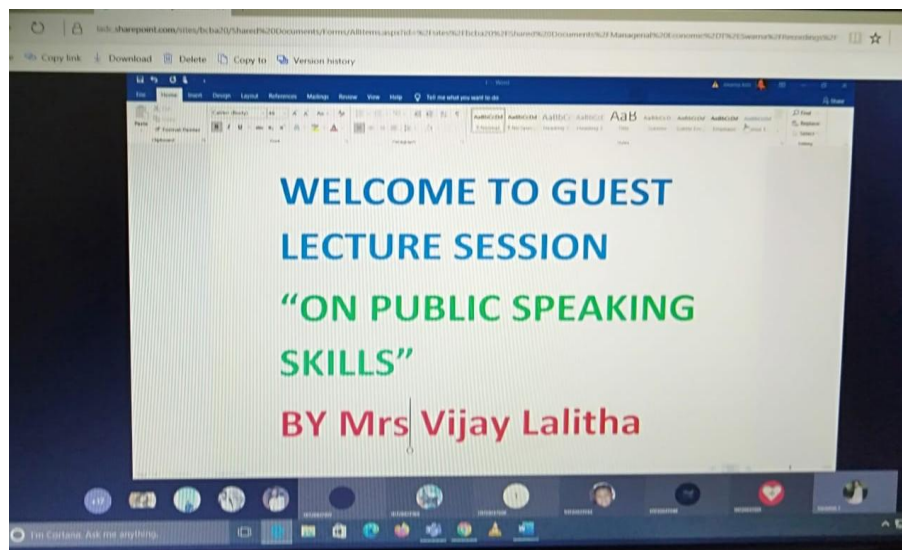
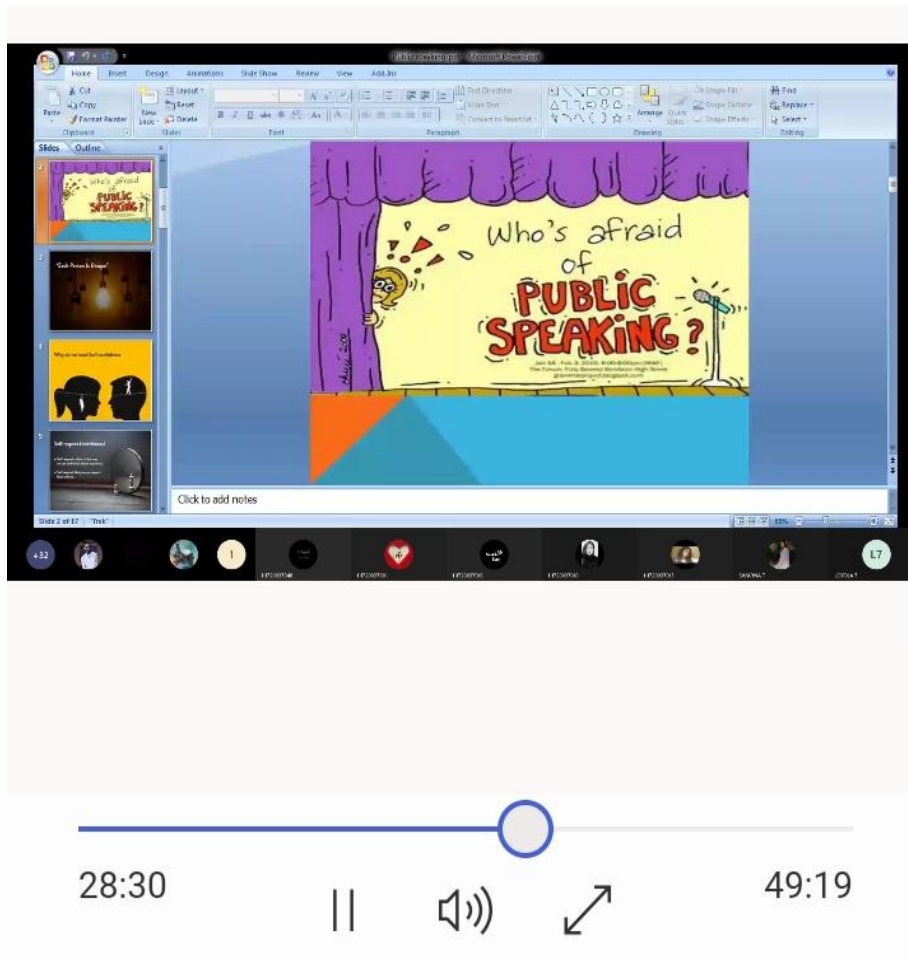
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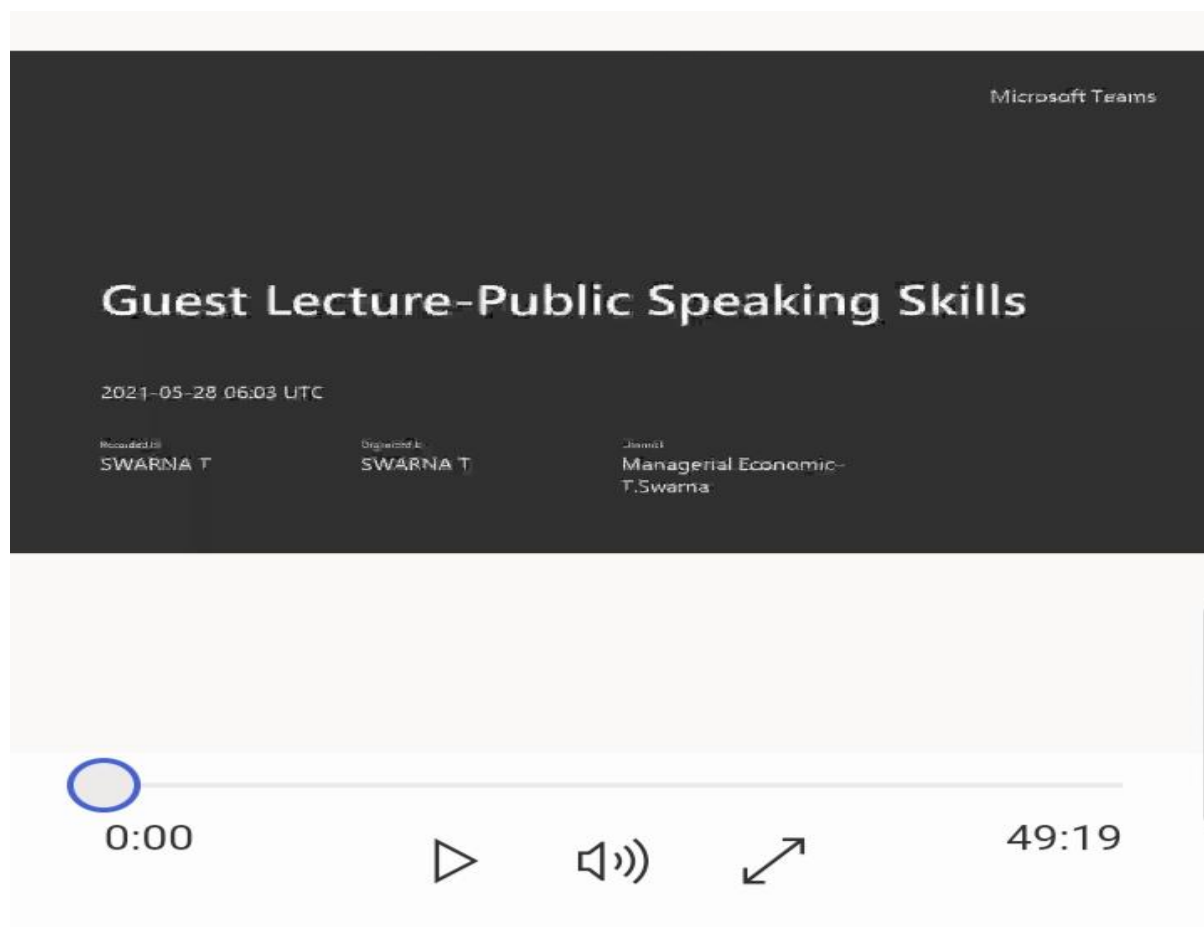

It was very informative and interactive session. The webinar has helped students understand the following ;

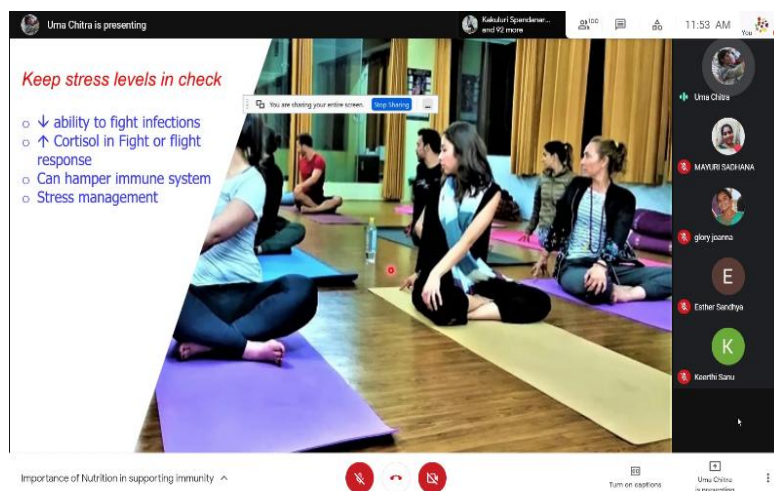
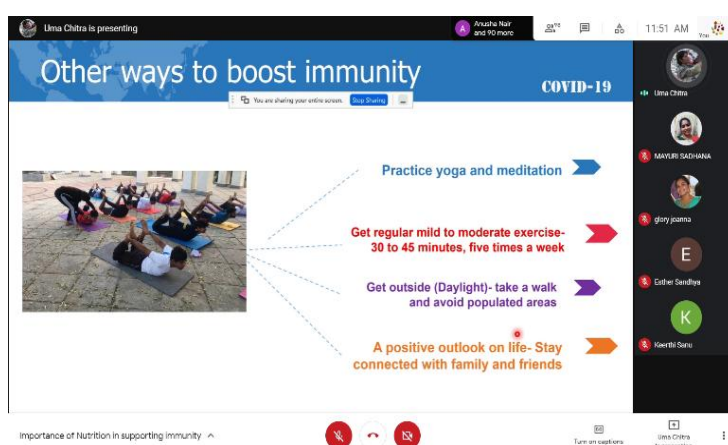
- Role of various foods that boost the immunity

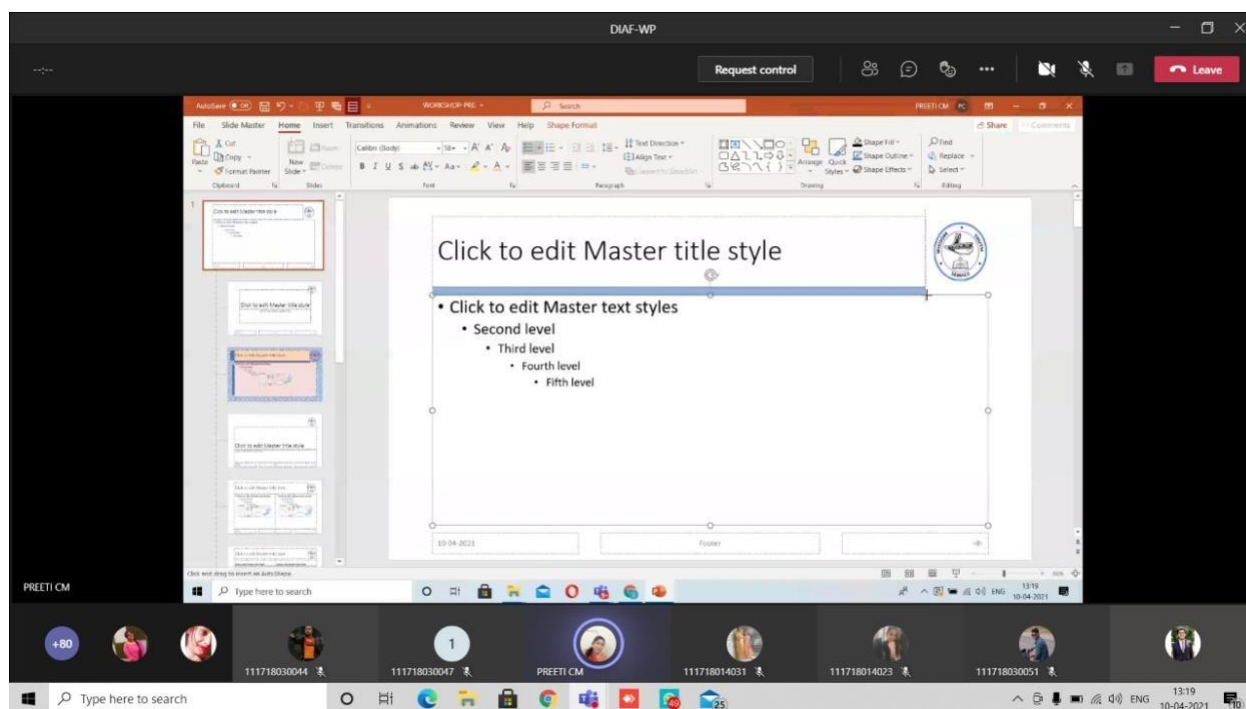
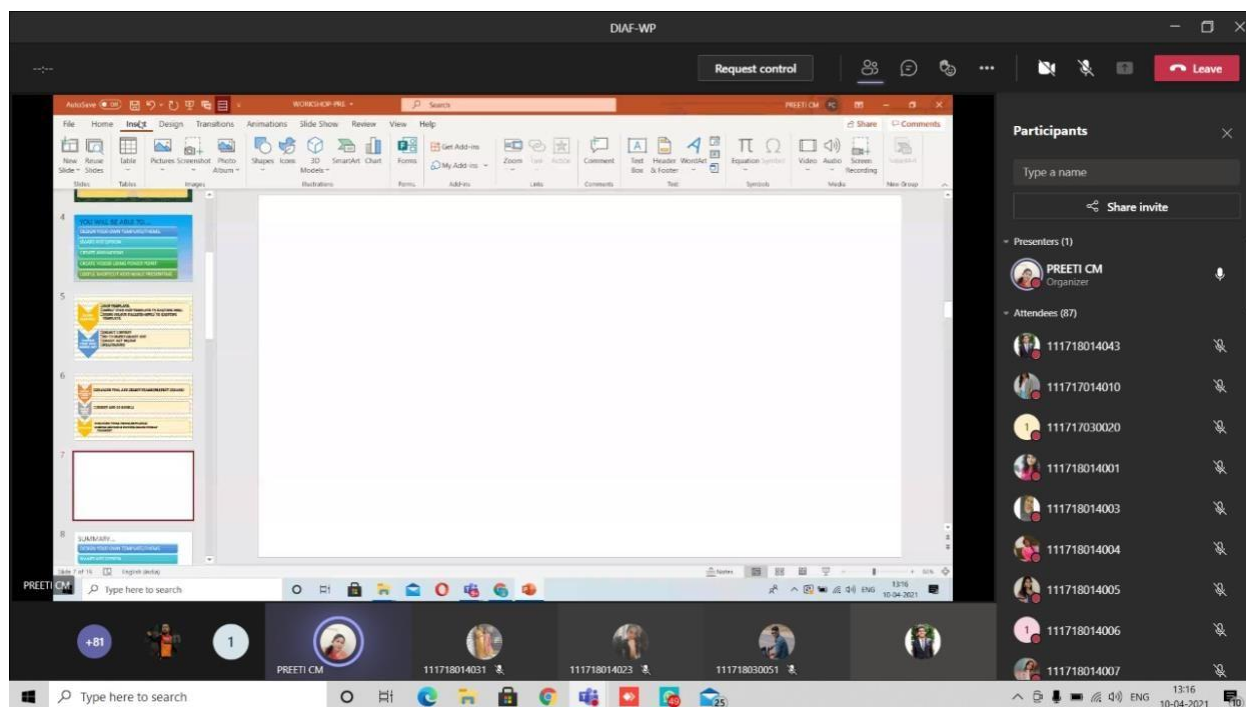
AIM- To give the students hands-on experience regarding the PowerPoint presentation of their projects

OBJECTIVES- The core objective of conducting the workshop is to make all the students understand the different and creative ways to present their PowerPoint presentation effectively.

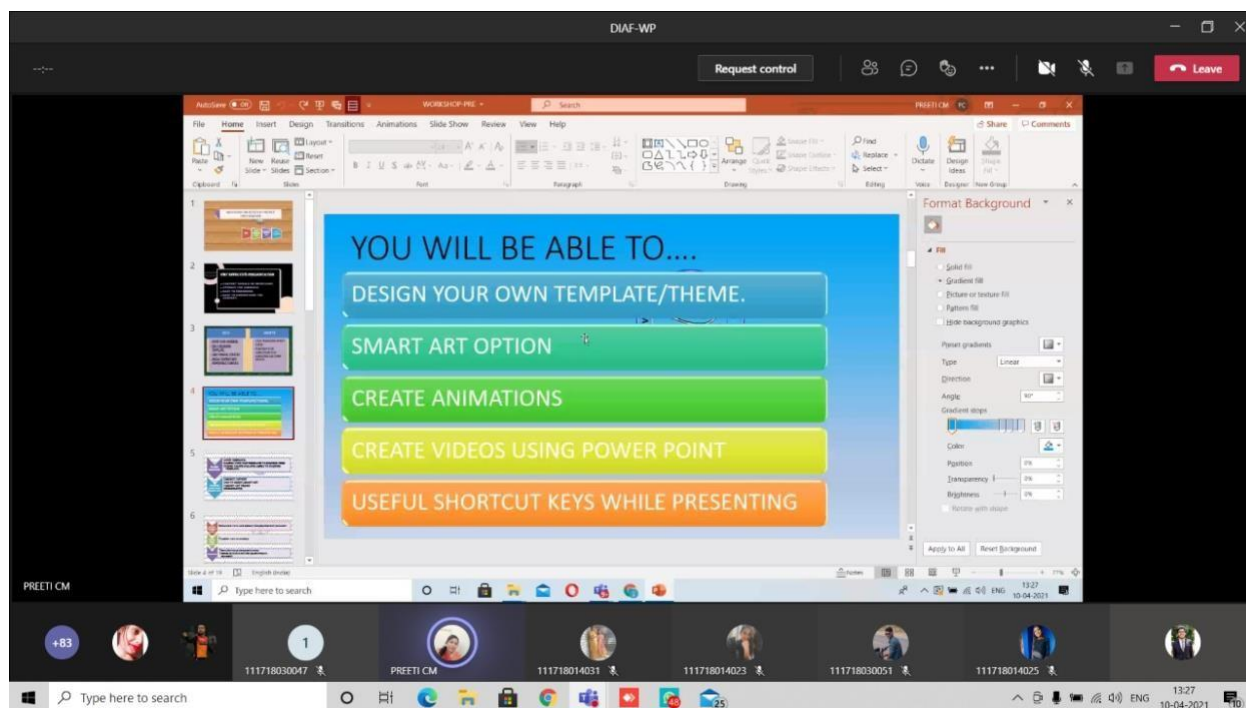
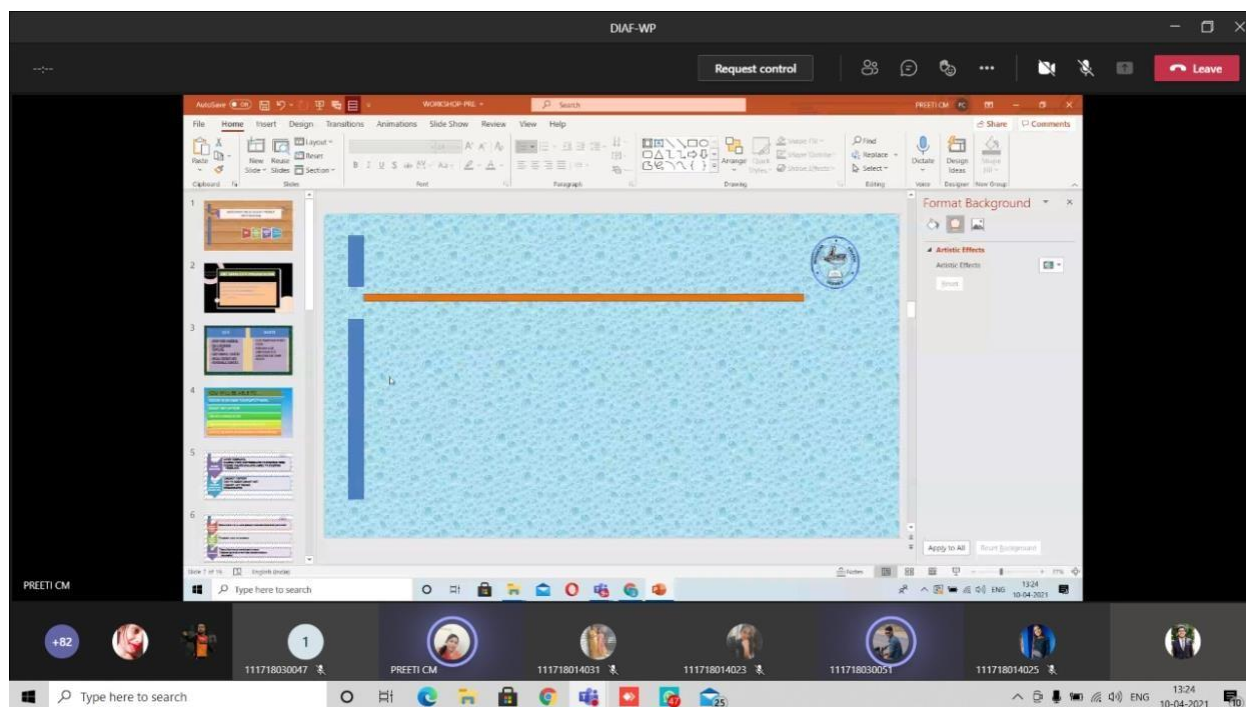
